Hello Administrator,

On February 27, 2023, Governor Mike Parson signed an early supplemental budget bill for Fiscal Year 2023-24, <u>House Bill No. 2</u>, that appropriated \$50 million in funding for School Safety Grants to support physical safety improvements in Local Education Agencies (LEAs) and Nonpublic Schools (NPS) across the state.

These funds will be distributed through the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education's FY24 School Safety Grant Program.

The FY2024 School Safety Grant Program is a competitive grant which aims to support Missouri's LEAs and NPS with valuable opportunities to improve their safety measures through physical safety upgrades. The grant application window will begin on August 3, 2023, and conclude on September 8, 2023. It is important to note that payments will be made on a reimbursement basis. Award notifications will be made on or about September 29, 2023.

**STEP #1** - The link to fill out the Grant Application is: Grant Application

**STEP #3** - Once you open the grant application and fill out information related to your school district, proceed to Section II of the Grant Application titled **"Proposed Grant Budget"**. This is where the brief description of the item is entered (Descriptions can be cut and pasted from the supplied information below). Note that you can enter multiple requests for different types of training and services on the same application.

**STEP #4** - Next, you will see a box marked **"Requested Amount"**, this is where the cost for the training is entered. Once the information is complete, the application can be submitted.

Programs that can be funded using this grant are:

### 3-Week Missouri School Protection Officer Training (In person) – Foundational Training

- In person training to allow school administrators and staff to be trained and certified as an armed Missouri School Protection Officer according to Missouri Statute 590.205.
- Pricing \$4497 to include all 112+ hours of training, all ammunition included, Stop the Bleed kits included and all training facilities and force on force equipment included.

4 hr. and 8 hr. Missouri School Protection Officer Training (In person) – Continuing Education

- In person training to allow school administrators and staff to receive continuing education required by Missouri Statute 590.205 to maintain certification as an armed Missouri School Protection Officer
- Pricing
  - 4 hr. Continuing Education \$267 per person
  - o 8 hr. Continuing Education \$447 per person
- \$4497 to include all 112+ hours of training, all ammunition included, Stop the Bleed kits included and all training facilities and force on force equipment included.
